

- Born July 6, 1907 in Mexico City
- Showed interest in art at a young age
- Father's friend Fernando Fernández who was a printmaker gave her drawing lessons
- Worked as an engraving apprentice for Fernando

Fernando was impressed with her talent but Frida did not consider art for her

career



- 18- in a serious bus accident which caused lifelong pain
- Was bedridden for 3 months and began painting
- Mother bought her a special made easel that let her paint in bed and her father let her borrow some oil paints
- Used painting to explore questions or identity and existence
- Often painted herself because she believed she was the subject she knew best



- Rumored to have had an affair with Georgia O'Keeffe and Josephine Baker
- Married Diego Rivera married in 1926
- Divorced in 1940 and remarried in 1940








Art considered magical realism

modern world while also adding magical elements







Died July 13 1954 at 47 in Mexico City of Pulmonary embolism




Significance
